5. (p. 62- in the previous lesson) Explain why the Muslims treated the Jews and Christians differently. Use specific detail from p. 62.

6. (p. 66-67) How did the first three caliphs after Muhammad use their armies?

7. Use the map on p. 67 to determine approximately how many times larger the Islamic empire was in 661 compared to its size when Muhammad died in 632 A.D.
