5 This project is above average, but lacks a certain distinctiveness of a six. The project meets and to some extent exceeds the requirements of the assignment. The thinking/reasoning/research/creative skills displayed are commendable. It is obvious that the student has shown care and effort in the completion of the work. Presentation is well-practiced and interesting.



4 This project reflects the average response; it neither excites nor disturbs the evaluator. The project meets all of the requirements of the assignment, but offers nothing extra. The thinking/reasoning/research/creative skills displayed are adequate. The project displays at least reasonable care and effort; lettering and pictures are well-organized, neat, and colorful. Presentation is good, but not exceptional.



3 This project is below average. There are deficiencies in this project which may disturb the evaluator. Not all requirements of the assignment have been fulfilled. Generally, these projects are brief and sketchy. The thinking/reasoning/research/creative skills displayed are inadequate. The project often looks rushed or as if it has been completed with marginal effort. Presentation may be dull or silly. The presenter seems ill-prepared.



2 This level of quality is unacceptable. Important requirements are missing or unfinished. Responses appear rushed or careless. Little evidence of thinking/reasoning/research or creative skills is displayed. The overall impression is poor. Presenter is clearly unprepared and not proud of his or her work.
