Interview Mini-Poster

(Note: 7th grade and 8th graders must have different colored cards to begin)

Assignment:

Step One: On one side of an index card, write your name, phone number, and enough physical descriptors (female, tall, shoulder-length dark brown hair, blue eyes) so that someone could identify you in the Nature Academy crowd.

Step Two: Hand in your card.

Step Three: Find the person whose card you drew. This person is now your partner. You will interview and create a mini-poster about your partner. You'll introduce your partner to the class tomorrow or later this week.

Step Four: Conduct a 5-10 minute interview of your partner to gather as much information as possible (you need not use everything on your poster.)

Step Five: Create a mini-poster (use a blank sheet of unlined 8.5-11" sheet of paper) that reveals as much as possible about your person.

Also:

- Write the person's name in large letters on the poster.
- Leave a 2"-3" space for a photo.
- Incorporate a border that reveals something about your person.
- Write your name in small letters on the lower right hand side.
- Use color! Be creative!

Sample Questions/Interest Areas:

- Favorite sports
- Favorite Songs/Music
- Prefer to text or talk
- What you want your friends to say about you
- Biggest Lifeskill strength and challenge
- Excursions that sound most appealing this year
- Easier to be a boy or girl?
- Favorite and Least Favorite school subjects
- Worst Nightmare
- Best memory of 6th grade
- Ideal birthday party
- Prefer a mountain or ocean vacation...
- The dessert I want tonight would be...
- Prefer to hike, swim, bike, climb, or kayak
- On a free afternoon, you'd probably find me...
