

# One Week Contract - Yosemite

1. Map of Yosemite: On a blank map of Yosemite (You'll need to trace one onto a sheet of paper), place and label at least three waterfalls, two lakes, three campgrounds, the Merced River, and three major peaks. Color your map and include a legend.
2. Complete a one page summary detailing the geologic history of Santa Cruz. You'll need to do research for this. You might try the library, internet, or the Santa Cruz Museum of Natural History. Keep a bibliography of the sources you use when completing this paper.
3. Write short paper (1-2 pages each) about one of the following:
  - the native people of Yosemite
  - John Muir
  - how Yosemite became a National ParkInformation must be in your own words, not downloaded from an internet site or copied directly from a text. Please write down the name and author of the texts or internet sites used for information.
4. Research at least 3 birds, 3 plants, 3 animals, 3 reptiles, and 3 insects that are native to the Yosemite Valley. Draw, color and describe one of each on an unlined piece of paper. You must draw and color the creatures yourself; do not print or xerox. Information must be in your own words, not downloaded from an internet site or copied directly from a text.
5. Use unlined paper to create a postcard. Fold the paper in half.. One half will be for writing to someone. (Be sure to look at a postcard and see how it is set up. The person's address should be on this side too.) Then use the other side to draw and color a picture which is representative of Yosemite.
6. Complete at least five complete math lessons. (The class is currently on Lesson \_\_\_\_)
7. Read at least 100 pages of your choice book.
8. Complete a one-point and two-point perspective landscape drawing (an outdoor scene).
9. Get at least one half hour of exercise daily. Keep a log describing what activity you did and how long you spent doing it.
